

CONSTRUCTION COMING TO TWIN OAKS VALLEY THIS FALL

TWIN OAKS PIPELINE RELINING PROJECT

PROJECT

The project will provide critical, preventive repairs to about 1 mile of a section of an underground water pipeline in the Twin Oaks Valley area.

LOCATION

The project is adjacent to N. Twin Oaks Valley Road, three miles past the Deer Springs Road intersection in the San Diego County unincorporated area, just north of the City of San Marcos.

PURPOSE

This work is needed to prevent pipeline breaks or failures and extend the service life of the pipeline.

TIMELINE

- Mid SeptemberConstruction begins
- Mid October

 Overnight work
- Mid–Late October until finish
 Normal construction
- Expected to finish Summer 2023

RESTORATION

CONSTRUCTION STARTS SOON TO RESTORE A DAMAGED SLOPE AT DULIN HILL

Construction will soon begin for this San Diego County Water Authority Project. Work for the Dulin Hill Restoration Project includes clearing and grading the slope, repairing erosion damage, extending water bars for improved erosion control, and replacing existing vegetation with native plants at its property near W Lilac Rd and Aqueduct Rd in Fallbrook.
