### PROPOSED ADJUSTMENT TO WATER RATES AND SERVICE CHARGES

Just a reminder that Rainbow Municipal Water District will hold a public hearing on February 26, 2013 at 1:00 p.m. in the Board Meeting Room regarding the proposed adoption of water rates or service charges. The District Board of Directors will consider adoption of those rates and charges after receiving public input at the public hearing on the 26th.

THE PROPOSED WATER AND SEWER RATES AND CHARGES WOULD BE EFFECTIVE FOR THE BILLING CYCLES BEGINNING APRIL 1, 2013 UNLESS NOTED OTHERWISE.

### **OPERATIONS & MAINTENANCE METER CHARGES**

The fixed monthly O & M meter charge is determined by the capacity (maximum flow) of the meter. The proposed rates listed in the chart below are calculated to recover 52% of Rainbow's fixed operating cost.

#### RESERVOIR UPGRADE FEE

Two years ago the District implemented a monthly meter charge for the purpose of funding reservoir upgrades mandated by the State of California and the Federal Environmental Protection Agency. The Reservoir Upgrade Charge is used to fund the planning, design, construction and related costs to bring our uncovered drinking water reservoirs into compliance with current health standards. The District has recently secured a low interest loan from the State Revolving Fund which allows us to greatly reduce the Reservoir Upgrade Fee. The State requires that the loan funds be used solely for the purpose of constructing the Morro and Beck Reservoir projects.

### **SEWER CHARGES**

The monthly sewer charge is based on your lowest monthly water usage for the period December 2011 through April 2012. The winter months represent the wettest season of the year therefore outdoor watering should be at its lowest levels which also equates to mostly indoor water usage that ultimately flows into the sewer system. The monthly sewer charge pays for the cost of collecting and treating the sewage as well as maintenance of the pipelines, pumps and equipment.
