RE: Draining to Repair the San Diego County Water Authority's Aqueduct February 28 through March 9, 2022

Dear Property Owner:
The San Diego County Water Authority is a public agency supplying wholesale water to agencies throughout San Diego County. Water provided to these agencies is conveyed through large-diameter pipelines, commonly referred to as aqueducts.

The Water Authority will be shutting down and draining one of its aqueducts in your area beginning February 28, 2022, in preparation for repair. The water will be released from our drainage structure into natural or man-made channels located at low points along the pipeline. We do not anticipate the discharge rate will exceed the capacity of these channels, and our crews will monitor the draining to ensure no problems arise. The draining will be completed by March 1, 2022.
